

AMENDMENT OFFERED

Representative Bentley offered the following amendment #2 to the bill, HB274, as amended:

On page 4, after line 2, insert the following new subsection (g):

(g) Determinations of fair and reasonable market value for ad valorem tax purposes pursuant to programs of countywide reappraisal or reappraisal of all taxable Class III property in any county of the State of Alabama that is not required to be appraised on the basis of its current use value which programs are conducted and supervised by the Department of Revenue pursuant to Chapter 7 of Title 40, Code of Alabama 1975, or any subsequent statutes of similar import, shall not be made more often than once every four years. Nothing in this amendment shall be deemed to affect the authority of duties of tax assessors or other county tax assessing officials to assess property for ad valorem taxation as otherwise required by the constitution and the laws of this state.
