8 On page 7, after line 24, add the following new  
9 Section 11, and renumber the subsequent sections accordingly:

10 Section 9. (a) When a person charged with a crime  
11 for which bail is required, is confined for any period in a  
12 county or municipal jail, a reasonable effort shall be made to  
13 determine the citizenship status of the person.

14 (b) If the person is a foreign national, the jailor  
15 or other officer having custody of the person shall make a  
16 reasonable effort to verify that the person has been lawfully  
17 admitted to the United States and, if lawfully admitted, that  
18 the lawful status has not expired. If verification of lawful  
19 status cannot be made from documents in the possession of the  
20 person, verification shall be made within 14 days through a  
21 query to the Law Enforcement Support Center of the United  
22 States Department of Homeland Security or other office or  
23 agency designated for that purpose by the United States  
24 Department of Homeland Security. If the lawful immigration  
25 status of the person cannot be verified, the jailor or other  
26 officer having custody of the person shall notify the United

1 States Department of Homeland Security and the person shall  
2 not be entitled to bond.
